

# **HUBUNGAN PENGETAHUAN DAN DUKUNGAN SUAMI DENGAN KEIKUTSERTAAN VAKSINASI COVID-19 PADA IBU HAMIL DI PUSKESMAS KASIHAN II TAHUN 2021**

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## **ABSTRAK**

**Latar Belakang :** Salah satu permasalahan yang sedang dihadapi pada masa pandemi ini adalah terkait kasus COVID-19 pada ibu hamil. Minat dari ibu hamil di Puskesmas Kasihan II terhadap imunisasi COVID-19 masih kurang dan belum memenuhi target. Tingkat pengetahuan vaksin COVID-19 maupun dukungan suami untuk melakukan vaksinasi COVID-19 pada ibu hamil sangat berpengaruh terhadap keinginan dan keberanian ibu untuk melakukan vaksinasi demi kesehatan ibu dan janin, meskipun sebelumnya banyak sekali isu dampak buruk vaksin COVID-19.

**Tujuan:** Mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan dan dukungan suami dengan keikutsertaan vaksinasi COVID-19 Pada Ibu Hamil di Puskesmas Kasihan II.

**Metode:** Penelitian *survey analitik* dengan desain *cross sectional*, menggunakan data primer dan skunder dengan kuesioner yang dibagikan dan lembar observasi yang akan di isi oleh peneliti. Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan *Proportional Sampling* sebanyak 60 responden. Analisis data menggunakan univariat dan analisis bivariat menggunakan *chi-square* dan Analisis Multivariat menggunakan uji *regresi logistik*.

**Hasil:** Mayoritas tingkat pengetahuan ibu hamil terhadap vaksinasi COVID-19 dalam kategori baik sebesar 65,0%, dukungan suami ibu hamil dalam keikutsertaan vaksinasi COVID-19 pada kategori baik sebesar 53,3% dan keikutsertaan ibu hamil dalam vaksinasi COVID-19 sebesar 80,0%. Ada hubungan pengetahuan ibu hamil dengan keikutsertaan vaksinasi COVID-19 di Puskesmas Kasihan II dengan nilai signifikan sebesar 0,000 ( $P<0,05$ ) dan ada hubungan dukungan suami dengan keikutsertaan vaksinasi COVID-19 di Puskesmas Kasihan II dengan nilai signifikan sebesar 0,019 ( $P<0,05$ ). Pengetahuan menjadi faktor paling dominan berpengaruh terhadap keikutsertaan vaksinasi COVID-19.

**Kesimpulan:** Ada hubungan pengetahuan dan dukungan suami dengan keikutsertaan vaksinasi COVID-19 di Puskesmas Kasihan II

# THE RELATIONSHIP OF KNOWLEDGE AND HUSBAND SUPPORT WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF THE COVID-19 VACCINATION ON PREGNANT WOMEN IN KASIHAN II PUSKESMAS IN 2021

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## ABSTRACT

**Background:** One of the problems being faced during this pandemic is related to cases of COVID-19 in pregnant women. Interest from pregnant women at the Kasihan II Health Center in COVID-19 immunization is still lacking and has not met the target. The level of knowledge of the COVID-19 vaccine as well as the husband's support for vaccinating against COVID-19 for pregnant women greatly influences the mother's desire and courage to vaccinate for the health of the mother and fetus, although previously there were many issues of the bad impact of the COVID-19 vaccine.

**Objective:** To determine the relationship between husband's knowledge and support with participation in COVID-19 vaccination for pregnant women at the Kasihan II Health Center.

**Methods:** Analytical survey research with cross sectional design, using primary and secondary data with questionnaires distributed and observation sheets to be filled in by the researcher. The sampling technique used is proportional sampling as many as 60 respondents. Data analysis using univariate and bivariate analysis using chi-square and Multivariate analysis using logistic regression test.

**Results:** The majority of pregnant women's level of knowledge on COVID-19 vaccination was in the good category by 65.0%, the husband's support for the participation of the COVID-19 vaccination in the good category was 53.3% and the participation of pregnant women in the COVID-19 vaccination was 80. ,0%. There is a relationship between knowledge of pregnant women and participation in COVID-19 vaccination at the Kasihan II Health Center with a significant value of 0.000 ( $P<0.05$ ) and there is a relationship between husband's support and participation in COVID-19 vaccination at the Kasihan II Health Center with a significant value of 0.019 ( $P< 0.05$ ). Knowledge is the most dominant factor influencing participation in COVID-19 vaccination.

**Conclusion:** There is a relationship between knowledge and husband's support with participation in COVID-19 vaccination at the Kasihan II Health Center.
