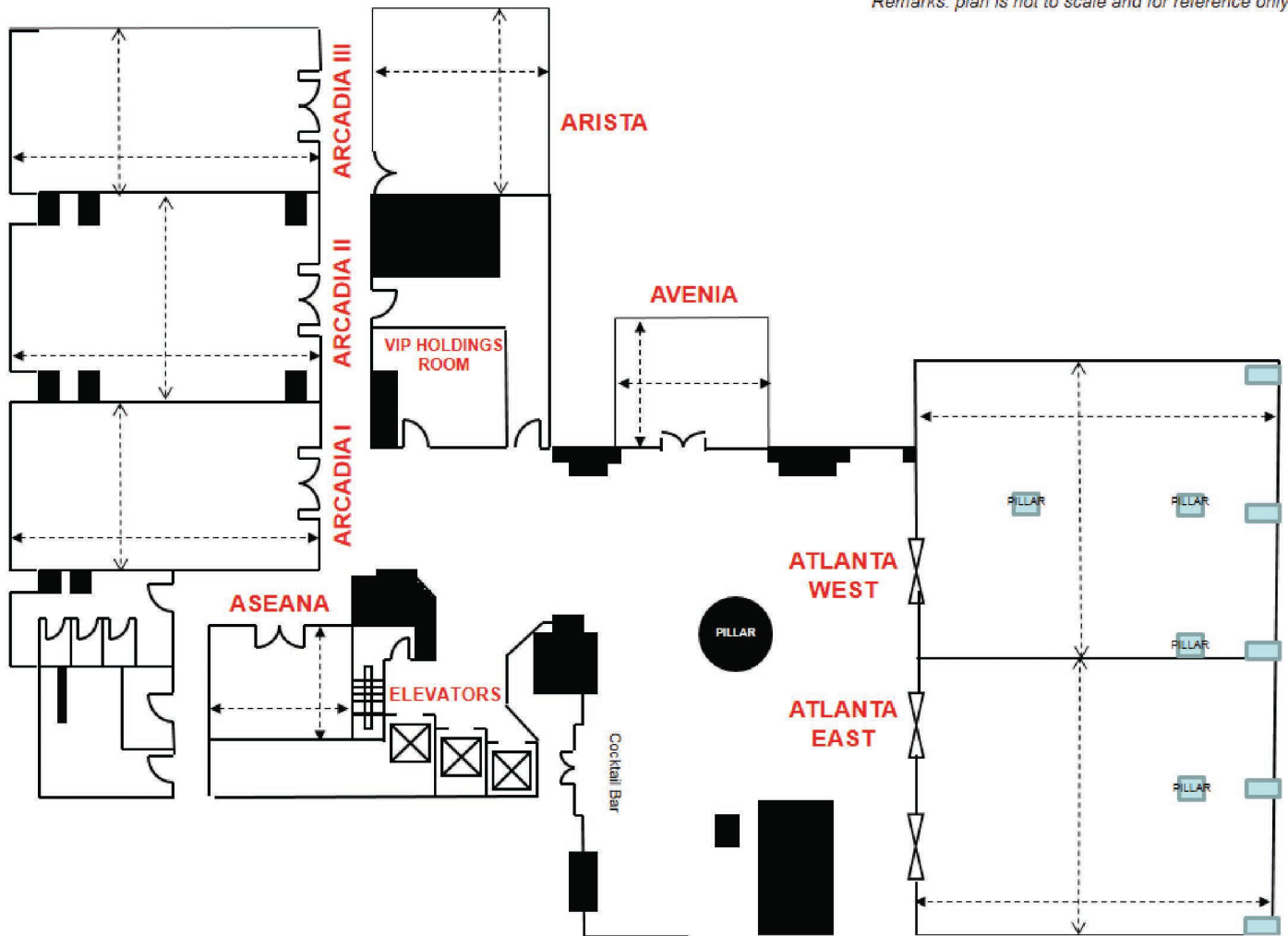

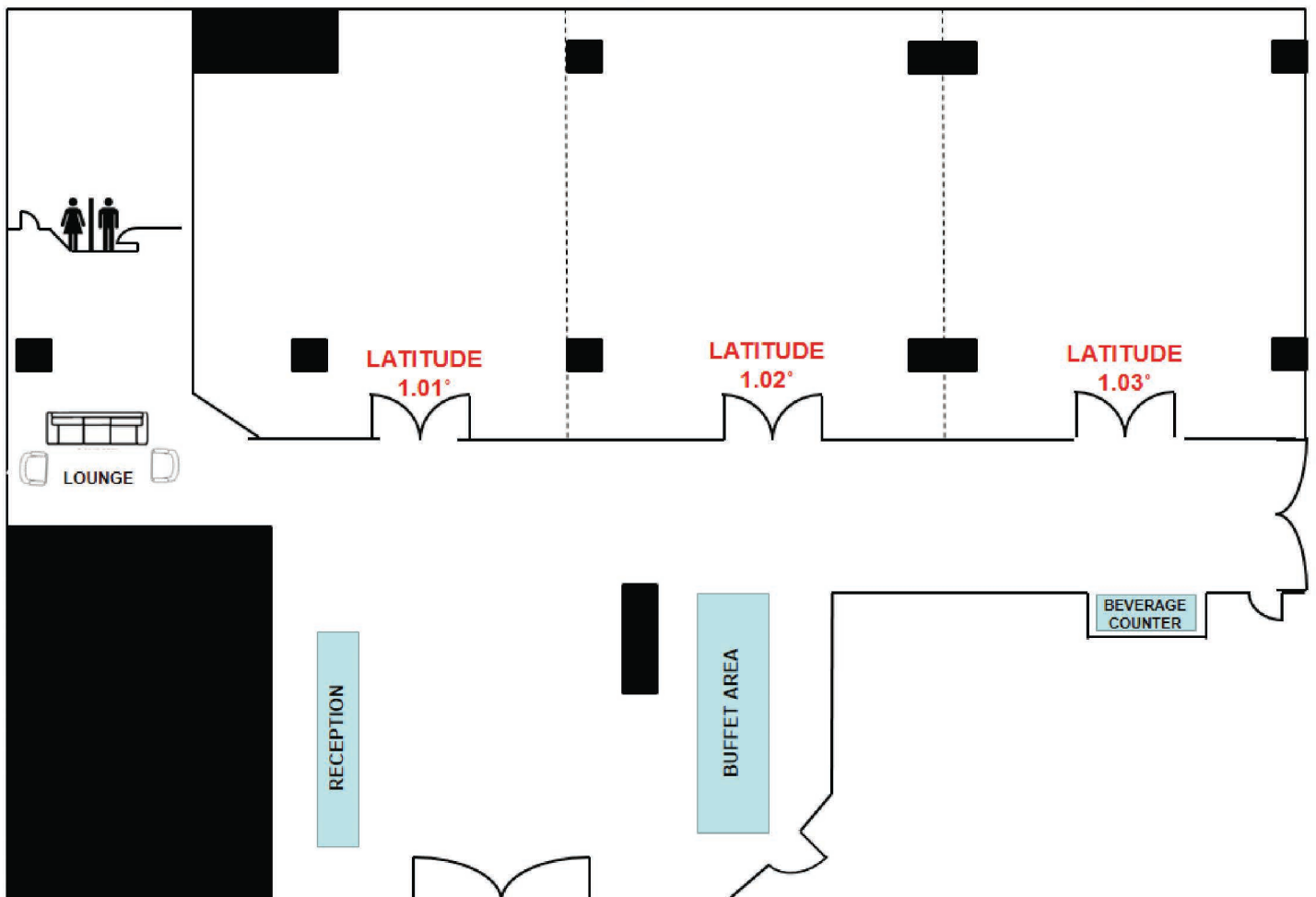
THE LATITUDE, LEVEL 3

Double blind: names of reviewers and authors are not revealed to each other

Open peer review: names of authors and reviewers are revealed to each other
