

**HUBUNGAN KEPATUHAN PERAWAT DALAM PELAKSANAAN
SIGN IN TERHADAP KETEPATAN TINDAKAN
OPERASI DI INSTALASI BEDAH SENTRAL
RSUP DR. SOERADJI TIRTONEGORO
KLATEN, TAHUN 2019.**

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INTISARI

Latar belakang : Kepatuhan perawat professional adalah sejauh mana perilaku seseorang perawat sesuai dengan ketaatan, pasrah, dan ketentuan tujuan terhadap aturan yang diberikan oleh pimpinan perawat ataupun rumah sakit. Kepatuhan perawat dapat di pengaruhi oleh faktor internal dan eksternal diantaranya adalah pengetahuan, motivasi, pendidikan, sikap, usia, jenis kelamin, masa kerja, kemampuan. Pelaksanaan sign in pada pre anastesi dilakukan untuk mencegah terjadinya kejadian yang tidak diharapkan. Pelaksanaan *sign in* pre anastesi dilakukan sebelum pasien diantarkan ke meja operasi. Manfaat pelaksanaan sign in keselamatan pasien terjamin, menurunkan angka kematian, menurunkan komplikasi akibat pembedahan. Dampak akibat tidak melakukan sign in salah pasien operasi, salah prosedur operasi, salah lokasi operasi.

Tujuan Penelitian : Untuk mengetahui hubungan kepatuhan perawat dalam pelaksanaan (*sign in*) terhadap ketepatan tindakan operasi di Instalasi Bedah Sentral RSUP Dr. Soeradji Tirtonegoro Klaten.

Metode Penelitian: Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kuantitatif, menggunakan desain observasi analitik dengan rancangan penelitian *cross sectional*. Penelitian ini dilaksanakan pada bulan Maret 2019. Subjek penelitian adalah populasi perawat yang bekerja di Instalasi Bedah Sentral RSUP DR. Soeradji Tirtonegoro Klaten yang terlibat dalam pelaksanaan sign in sebanyak 35 orang. Analisa data menggunakan deskriptif. Uji statistik menggunakan uji *Fisher'Exact Test* dengan nilai $p < 0,05$.

Hasil Penelitian : hasil penelitian menunjukkan 23 orang (65,71%) dari 35 responden perawat dengan kategori patuh dan 12 orang (34,28%) kategori tidak patuh. Ketepatan tindakan operasi kategori tepat lokasi, tepat prosedur dan tepat pasien pada 29 orang (82,85%) dari 35 orang yang dilaksanakan operasi sedangkan kategori tidak tepat sebanyak 6 orang (17,14%) dari 35 orang yang dilakukan operasi.

Kesimpulan : Ada hubungan yang bermakna antara kepatuhan perawat dalam pelaksanaan *sign in* dengan ketepatan tindakan operasi.

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**RELATIONSHIP OF NURSE COMPLIANCE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SIGN IN

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ABSTRACT

Background : Compliance with professional nurses is the extent to which the behavior of the nurse is in accordance with obedience, resignation, and the provision of goals towards the rules given by the nurse or hospital leader. Nurse compliance can be influenced by internal and external factors including knowledge, motivation, education, attitude, age, gender, years of work, ability. The implementation of the sign-in for pre-anesthesia is done to prevent unexpected events. The implementation of the pre-anesthesia sign is carried out before the patient is delivered to the operating table. The benefits of implementing patient safety signs are guaranteed, reducing mortality, reducing surgical complications. The impact of the surgery is not correct, it is not a sign that the patient is having surgery or a wrong procedure.

Objective: To determine the relationship of nurse compliance in the implementation (*sign in*) of the accuracy of surgery in Instalai Central Surgery Dr. Soeradji Tirtonegoro Klaten.

Research Method: This research is a quantitative research, using analytic observation design with cross sectional research design. This research was conducted in March 2019. The research subjects were the population of nurses working in the Central Surgical Installation of RSUP DR. Soeradji Tirtonegoro Klaten involved in the implementation of the sign-in as many as 35 people. Data analysis uses descriptive. Statistical tests using the Fisher' Exact Test with a value of $p < 0.05$.

Research Results: the results of the study showed 23 people (65.71%) of 35 nurse respondents with obedient categories and 12 people (34.28%) in non-compliant categories. The accuracy of surgery is in the right location, right procedure and patient category in 29 people (82.85%) out of 35 people who carried out the operation while in the wrong category there were 6 people (17.14%) out of 35 people who were operated.

Conclusion: There is a relationship of nurse compliance in the implementation of sign in with the accuracy of the operation.
