

GAMBARAN SARANA SANITASI DAN PERILAKU HIDUP BERSIH SEHAT (PHBS) DI PASAR SIDOREJO KALASAN PADA MASA PANDEMI COVID-19

INTISARI

Tempat-tempat umum merupakan tempat yang mempunyai potensi terjadinya penularan penyakit, pencemaran lingkungan, atau gangguan kesehatan lainnya. Pasar tradisional menjadi salah satu klaster penyebaran COVID-19 di sejumlah daerah dikarenakan banyaknya pedagang pasar tradisional yang terjangkit virus COVID-19. Berdasarkan hasil studi pendahuluan, terdapat beberapa permasalahan seperti sarana sanitasi yang kurang memenuhi syarat kesehatan, serta belum diterapkan protokol kesehatan COVID-19 dalam pasar. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah mengetahui gambaran kondisi sarana sanitasi dan perilaku hidup bersih sehat (PHBS) di Pasar Sidorejo pada Masa Pandemi COVID-19.

Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah survei analisis deskriptif. Sampel dalam penelitian ini adalah pedagang, pengunjung, dan pengelola Pasar Sidorejo. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa penilaian sarana kamar mandi/toilet dengan skor 1.200 atau 60% pada kategori cukup, pengelolaan sampah dengan skor 1.200 atau 40% pada kategori kurang, dan tempat cuci tangan dengan skor 1.000 atau 100% pada kategori memenuhi, penilaian perilaku pedagang/pekerja dengan skor 2.400 atau 63% pada kategori cukup, perilaku pengunjung dengan skor 1.040 atau 42% pada kategori kurang, dan perilaku pengelola pasar dengan skor 1.330 atau 100% pada kategori memenuhi.

Kesimpulan penelitian Kondisi sarana sanitasi di Pasar Sidorejo kategori kurang memenuhi syarat, dan Kondisi Perilaku Hidup Bersih Sehat (PHBS) di Pasar Sidorejo kategori cukup memenuhi syarat.

DESCRIPTION OF SANITATION FACILITIES AND CLEAN HEALTHY LIVING BEHAVIOR (PHBS) AT THE SIDOREJO KALASAN MARKET DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

ABSTRACT

Public places are places that have the potential for disease transmission, environmental pollution, or other health problems. Traditional markets are one of the clusters of the spread of COVID-19 in a number of areas due to the large number of traditional market traders who have contracted the COVID-19 virus. Based on the results of the preliminary study, there are several problems such as sanitation facilities that do not meet health requirements, and the COVID-19 health protocol has not been implemented in the market. The purpose of this study was to describe the condition of sanitation facilities and clean and healthy living behavior (PHBS) in Sidorejo Market during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

The research method used is descriptive analysis survey. The samples in this study were traders, visitors, and managers of Sidorejo Market. The results showed that the assessment of bathroom/toilet facilities with a score of 1,200 or 60% in the sufficient category, waste management with a score of 1,200 or 40% in the less category, and hand washing facilities with a score of 1,000 or 100% in the meet category. workers with a score of 2,400 or 63% in the sufficient category, visitor behavior with a score of 1,040 or 42% in the less category, and behavior of market managers with a score of 1,330 or 100% in the fulfilling category.

The conclusion of this research is that the condition of sanitation facilities in Sidorejo Market does not meet the requirements, and the Condition of Clean and Healthy Behavior (PHBS) in the Sidorejo Market is in the category of sufficiently fulfilling the requirements.
