

HUBUNGAN DUKUNGAN SUAMI TERHADAP KUNJUNGAN NEONATAL
PADA MASA PANDEMI COVID-19 DI WILAYAH KERJA PUSKESMAS
PANJATAN II KABUPATEN KULON PROGO TAHUN 2020

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ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: Kematian bayi di tahun 2020 adalah salah satu prioritas nasional dibidang kesehatan ibu dan anak yang belum terselesaikan. Berdasarkan hasil SDKI, provinsi DIY memiliki cakupan KN lengkap paling rendah di tahun 2018 sebesar 72,12%. Data dari Profil Kesehatan Kabupaten Kulon Progo, menunjukkan bahwa terjadi penurunan prevalensi kunjungan neonatal pada tahun 2012 dan 2017 sebesar 94,7% dan 88,3%. Menurut studi pendahuluan cakupan kunjungan neonatal rendah dan salah satu yang memiliki program inovasi “Mata Hati” dibidang kesehatan ibu dan anak di Kulon Progo adalah Puskesmas Panjatan II sebesar 67,4%.

Tujuan: Mengetahui hubungan dukungan suami terhadap kunjungan neonatal lengkap pada masa pandemi COVID-19 di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Panjatan II Kabupaten Kulon Progo.

Metode: Penelitian ini adalah observasional analitik dengan desain *cross-sectional*. Penelitian ini dilaksanakan bulan November 2020-April 2021. Populasi penelitian adalah ibu yang memiliki anak 1-2 bulan di Wilayah Kerja Puskesmas Panjatan II, teknik pengambilan data *quota sampling*. Sampel berjumlah 85 responden. Instrumen penelitian ini adalah *google form*. Variabel yang diteliti meliputi dukungan suami sebagai variabel independen. Kunjungan Neonatal sebagai variabel dependen. Analisis data dalam penelitian dengan univariat dan bivariat(*Chi-square*).

Hasil: Proporsi kunjungan neonatal lengkap sebagian besar adalah ibu yang mendapat dukungan dari suami (62,5%), sedangkan kunjungan neonatal yang tidak lengkap hampir semuanya tidak mendapatkan dukungan dari suami maupun keluarga (84,4%). Hasil nilai $p=0,000 < 0,05$ (OR= 9,048) terdapat hubungan antara dukungan suami dengan kelengkapan kunjungan neonatal di Puskesmas Panjatan II.

Kesimpulan: Ada hubungan antara dukungan suami dengan kelengkapan kunjungan neonatal. Ibu yang mendapat dukungan suami memiliki kemungkinan 9 kali lebih besar untuk melakukan kunjungan neonatal lengkap.

RELATIONSHIP OF HUSBAND SUPPORT TO NEONATAL VISIT DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC IN THE WORKING AREA OF PANJATAN PUSKESMAS II, KULON PROGO REGENCY IN 2020

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ABSTRACT

Background: Infant mortality in 2020 is one of the unresolved national priorities in the field of maternal and child health. Based on the results SDKI (Survei Demografi dan Kesehatan Indonesia), the Special Region of Yogyakarta Province had the lowest complete neonatal visit coverage in 2018 at 72.12%. Data from the Health Profile of Kulon Progo Regency, shows that there was a decrease in the prevalence of neonatal visits in 2012 and 2017 by 94.7% and 88.3%, respectively. According to a preliminary study, the coverage of neonatal visits is low and one of the ones that has the “Mata Hati” innovation program in the field of maternal and child health in Kulon Progo is the Panjatan II Primary Health Center 67.4%.

Objective: To determine the relationship between husband's support for complete neonatal visits during the COVID-19 pandemic in the Panjatan II Public Health Center, Kulon Progo Regency.

Methods: This study was an analytic observational with design *cross-sectional*. This research was carried out in November 2020-April 2021. The research population was mothers who had 1-2 months of children in the Panjatan II Health Center Work Area, data collection *quota sampling technique*. The sample is 85 respondents. The instrument of this research is the *google form*. The variables studied included husband's support as an independent variable. Neonatal visits as the dependent variable. Data analysis in the study was univariate and bivariate (*Chi-square*).

Results: the proportion of complete neonatal visits was mostly mothers who received support from their husbands (62.5%), while almost all incomplete neonatal visits did not receive support from their husbands or families (84.4%). The result of p-value = $0.000 < 0.05$ (OR = 9.048) there is a relationship between the husband's support and the completeness of neonatal visits at the Panjatan II Health Center.

Conclusion: There is a relationship between the husband's support and the completeness of neonatal visits. Mothers who received their husband's support were 9 times more likely to have complete neonatal visits.
