ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: : Pelayanan KB di masa Covid-19 terhambat akibat akses ke fasilitas pelayanan kesehatan sangat terbatas dan penduduk mungkin menghindari mencari fasilitas pelayanan yang tersedia karena kekhawatiran bahwa mereka akan terkontaminasi COVID-19.

Tujuan: Mengetahui faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan kepatuhan akseptor KB suntik kombinasi di Praktik Mandiri Bidan Susanti.

Metode: Penelitian ini adalah penelitian deskriptif kuantitatif dengan desain *cross sectional*. Populasinya adalah seluruh akseptor lama KB suntik kombinasi yang melakukan kunjungan ulang pada masa pandemi COVID-19 di PMB Susanti dengan sampel penelitian sebanyak 150 orang dengan teknik pengambilan sampel *total sampling*. Analisis data dalam penelitian ini menggunakan uji *Chi-Square*.

Hasil: Tidak ada hubungan faktor pendidikan ($p=0,790$), pekerjaan ($p=0,454$), dukungan suami ($p=0,285$), dan jarak akses ke pelayanan kesehatan ($p=0,790$) dengan tingkat kepatuhan kunjungan ulang KB suntik kombinasi di Praktik Mandiri Bidan Susanti. Ada hubungan zona tempat tinggal ($p=0,000$) dan kecemasan ibu ($p=0,000$) dengan tingkat kepatuhan kunjungan ulang KB suntik kombinasi di Praktik Mandiri Bidan Susanti.

Kesimpulan: Ada hubungan zona tempat tinggal dan tingkat kepatuhan dengan kecemasan kunjungan ulang KB suntik kombinasi pada masa pandemi COVID-19.
