

HUBUNGAN TINGKAT PENGETAHUAN IBU HAMIL DAN DUKUNGAN SUAMI DENGAN KEPATUHAN KUNJUNGAN *ANTENATAL CARE* SELAMA MASA PANDEMI COVID-19 DI RSUD NYI AGENG SERANG TAHUN 2021

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ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: *Antenatal care* (ANC) merupakan pelayanan kesehatan kepada ibu hamil selama masa kehamilannya, sesuai dengan standar pelayanan antenatal. Pelayanan ANC pada saat pandemi *Corona Virus Disease 2019* (Covid-19) saat ini tentunya akan sangat terpengaruh dan berisiko mengalami penurunan kunjungan termasuk K6. Penerapan perilaku kunjungan ANC sesuai protokol kesehatan tersebut tentunya sangat dipengaruhi oleh pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang ANC di masa pandemi dan juga dukungan keluarga.

Tujuan: Untuk mengetahui hubungan tingkat pengetahuan sikap ibu hamil dan dukungan suami dengan kepatuhan kunjungan *antenatal care* selama masa pandemi Covid-19 di RSUD Nyi Ageng Serang tahun 2021.

Metode Penelitian: Desain penelitian yang digunakan adalah *cross sectional*. Sampel dalam penelitian ini adalah 55 ibu hamil trimester III dengan umur kehamilan ≥ 37 minggu yang melakukan kunjungan ANC di RSUD Nyi Ageng Serang dan akan bersalin di RSUD Nyi Ageng Serang. Pengambilan sampel dilakukan dengan *purposive sampling*. Analisis data menggunakan uji *chi square*. Alat ukur yang digunakan yaitu kuesioner.

Hasil Penelitian: Terdapat hubungan yang bermakna antara tingkat pengetahuan ibu hamil dan dukungan suami dengan kepatuhan kunjungan *antenatal care* selama masa pandemi Covid-19 di RSUD Nyi Ageng Serang (p-value: 0,001). Sebanyak 81,8% ibu hamil memiliki pengetahuan baik dan 81,8% ibu mendapatkan dukungan suami yang baik. Ibu hamil yang patuh melakukan ANC selama pandemi Covid-19 sebanyak 85,55%.

Kesimpulan: Terdapat hubungan yang bermakna antara tingkat pengetahuan ibu hamil dan dukungan suami dengan kepatuhan kunjungan *antenatal care* selama masa pandemi Covid-19 di RSUD Nyi Ageng Serang.

THE KNOWLEDGE LEVEL OF PREGNANT MOTHERS AND HUSBAND SUPPORT TOWARDS *ANTENATAL CARE VISIT* COMPLIANCE DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AT NYI AGENG SERANG HOSPITAL IN 2021

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ABSTRACT

Background: *Antenatal Care* (ANC) is a health care provided for mothers during their pregnancy period, based on ANC standard. During *Corona Virus Disease 2019* (Covid-19) pandemic, ANC has been tremendously effected and indicated a risk of simultaneously decreasing visit, including the K6. The application of ANC visit with health protocol has not only been strongly influenced by the knowledge level of pregnant mothers towards ANC during the pandemic but also the support of the family.

Purpose: To define the correlation between knowledge level of pregnant mothers and husband support towards *antenatal care visit* obedience during Covid-19 pandemic at Nyi Ageng Serang Hospital at 2021.

Research Method: This research applied a *cross sectional* method. The samples were taken from 55 pregnant mothers in third trimester pregnancy with more than 37 weeks age of pregnancy conducting ANC visit at Nyi Ageng Serang Hospital and planned on delivering at the same place. These samples were obtained through *purposive sampling*. The data analysis applied was *chi square test* and questionnaire was used as the measuring tools.

Results: There was significant correlation between the knowledge level of pregnant mothers and husband support with *antenatal care visit* obedience during Covid-19 pandemic at Nyi Ageng Serang Hospital (p-value: 0.001). Eighty one point eight percent (81.8 %) pregnant mothers had good knowledge levels and 81.8% of these mothers received good support from the husband. The number of pregnant mother conducting ANC during the Covid -19 pandemic was 85.55 %.

Conclusion: There was relevant correlation found between knowledge level of pregnant mothers and husband support towards *antenatal care visit* obedience during Covid-19 pandemic at Nyi Ageng Serang Hospital.
