INTISARI

Latar Belakang : Tingkat kepedulian masyarakat terhadap Bank Sampah Gemah Ripah Bantul berkembang secara bertahap dan menunjukkan trend positif. Masyarakat yang antusias berpartisipasi dalam menabung sampah masyarakat yang memiliki pengetahuan yang baik tentang manfaat menabung sampah dan pengelolaan sampah yang baik lebih peduli untuk berpartisipasi. Tetapi masih ada beberapa masyarakat yang kurang aktif dalam menabung di bank sampah.

Tujuan: Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui partisipasi masyarakat, faktor – faktor yang mempengaruhi partisipasi, teknik operasional pengelolaan bank sampah dan sarana dan prasarana bank sampah.

Metode: Jenis penelitian yang digunakan yaitu survey deskriptif. Populasi dan sampel pada penelitian yaitu masyarakat Dusun Badegan dengan sampel sebanyak 87 masyarakat.

Hasil: Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa tingkat partisipasi masyarakat yang menabung di bank sampah sebanyak 51,72% , faktor-faktor yang mempengaruhi partisipasi yaitu karena masyarakat ingin memperbaiki kualitas lingkungan, meningkatkan pengetahuan tentang pengelolaan sampah dan menambah pendapatan. Teknik operasional pengelolaan bank sampah terdapat 2 komponen yang belum memenuhi syarat, sarana dan prasarana bank sampah terdapat 4 komponen yang belum memenuhi syarat.

Kesimpulan: Kesimpulan dari penelitian ini adalah partisipasi masyarakat dalam kategori “Rendah”, faktor yang mempengaruhi partisipasi yaitu ingin menambah pendapatan, memperbaiki kualitas lingkungan dan meningkatkan pengetahuan tentang pengelolaan sampah teknik operasional pengelolaan bank sampah ada 2 komponen belum memenuhi syarat, sarana dan prasarana ada 4 komponen belum memenuhi syarat.

ABSTRAC

Background : The level of community awarness towards the Gemah Ripah Waste Bank in Bantul is developing gradually and showing a positive trend. Enthusiastic community members participate in saving waste, and those who have a good understanding of the benefits of saving waste and proper waste management are more likely to engage. However, there are still some community members who are less active in saving at the waste bank.

Objective: The purpose of this study was to determine community participation, factors that influence participation, operational techniques for managing waste banks and waste bank facilities and infrastructure.

Method: The type of research used is descriptive survey. The population and sample in the study are the people of Dusun Badegan with a sample of 87 people.'

Results: The research shows that the level of community participation in saving at waste banks is 51,72%. The factors influencing participation are that the community wants to improve environmental quality, enhance knowledge about waste management, and increase income. The operational techniques for managing waste banks have 2 components that do not meet the requirements, while the facilities and infrastructure of waste banks have 4 components that do not meet the requirements.

Conclusion: The conclusion of this study is that community participation is in the "Low" category, factors that influence participation are wanting to increase income, improve environmental quality and increase knowledge about waste management, operational techniques for managing waste banks, there are 2 components that do not meet the requirements, facilities and infrastructure, there are 4 components that do not meet the requirements.
